

Taungoo Dynasty & Bago Yoma Nature (3Days – 2Nights)

Just 4-hour drive from Yangon, the ancient city of Taungoo displays the treasurable remains of the glorious empire in Myanmar's history. The city sits on the slow-moving Sittaung River. Not only the historical significance, Taungoo is also a great place for soft trekking and spending enjoyable time around local villages. Experience the laid-back pace of life by interacting with local tribes at the vibrant local markets and cheroot factory.



Day 1: Yangon – Taungoo (D)

Taungoo is an ancient city which was built in 16th century and Taungoo Empire was the biggest in history. The city is also known for its areca palms producing Burmese loved betel nuts. Sightseeing around in Taungoo and at first we will go to the remaining of old city wall and moat and the memorial of city founder of King Min Gyi Nyo who founded the first Taungoo Dynasty (1485–1599) at Taungoo far up the Sittaung River south of Inwa towards the end of the Ava Kingdom in 1510. Then continue to visit Kantawgyi Lake situated in the southwestern part of the old city, and it is also known as Legyunkandaw, meaning the royal lake with four islands and Shwesandaw Pagoda, the landmark of the city. Dinner & overnight at the hotel in Taungoo.

Day 2: Taungoo – villages trekking & sightseeing (B/L/D)

Morning breakfast at the hotel. Walking through three villages and farms for one and half hour. On the way at the local villages for knowledge about the rural daily life. Cross Sittaung River by local ferry around 8:30 am. Trekking along Golden road on eastern bank of Sittaung River. Arrive Myat Saw Nyi Naung pagoda around 10am. Lunch at pagoda and afternoon break. Start trekking at 3pm from pagoda on short cut to Taungoo along villages. Sunset watching at Sittaung River. Arrive back at Hotel around 6 pm. Dinner & overnight at the hotel in Taungoo.

Day 03: Taungoo sightseeing (B)

Breakfast at your hotel. Start the sightseeing at 08:30am. Visit bustling Taungoo's central markets and Cheroot factory to learn about local daily life. After that visit to the Taungoo train station which is interesting places to see real life style of local people. Then visit to Myazigon Pagoda is a Buddhist temple in Taungoo. Built in either the 16th or 19th century the temple contains several images of members of the Toungoo dynasty and a large sitting bronze statue of the Buddha. Then back to the hotel and refreshment. If you wish you could walk through rice-fields to farmer's villages which is right next to hotel. Check out from the hotel at 12:00pm.


